## The Senior Artists Network

Senior Artists Network (SAN) is a not-for-profit, tax-exempt organization committed to promoting and fostering the talents of Chicago-area artists, age 50 or older. SAN is operated by a volunteer board representing a diverse membership from all ethnic and racial backgrounds.

## Filling a Need in Chicago

SAN was founded to provide access to exhibition opportunities for artists age 50 and over and to the resources needed to create art.

SAN remains unique in the Chicago metropolitan area as the sole art group committed to these professional artists.

## How We Started

The Senior Artists Network (formerly the Senior Citizens Art Network) began in 1988 for the purpose of showcasing the work of accomplished artists over 60. In 1989, SAN was incorporated as a not-for-profit organization with 501(c)3 status. Our first inaugural juried art exhibition, **Later Impressions**, was held in November of 1989 at the Richard J. Daley Center and the State of Illinois Building. It was the result of a collaborative effort among public and

private organizations and the artists themselves. It was funded by the Retirement Research Foundation, the Sara Lee Foundation, the Chicago Department of Cultural Affairs, and the Illinois Arts Council, a state agency, as well as by membership fees and donations. In 1997, the group changed its name to SAN, and in 2000 lowered its membership age to 50 to reflect its broader goals.
